The ornamental design for a crosswalk button, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of the fist;  
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a front 15 degrees titled view thereof.  
The broken line portions of the crosswalk button in all views represent unclaimed portions of the claimed design and form no part thereof.
